



A public hearing is scheduled for 7 PM on 1/6/2021 at Taylor Town Hall.

WHAT?

The Town of Taylor is proposing to raise the Town sales tax rate by 1%, begin charging a 3% sales tax on utilities and telecommunications, and incorporate a Use Tax.

WHY?

The Town wants to maintain its level of medical, fire, and police response. The Town seeks to raise additional revenue, to support the expanding cost of this critical service. The demand for these services continues to increase year over year.

WHO?

Purchases made within Town limits would be impacted. Here are some examples
\$1 cup of coffee: \$0.01 in additional taxes
\$10 meal: \$0.10 in additional taxes
\$50 stay in a hotel: \$0.50 in additional taxes

WHEN?

The rate change could go into effect April 1, 2022.

HOW?

Many towns, charge a property tax to pay for their emergency response services. In our Town, the cost is covered by sales tax, fees for service, and other sources.
